them...



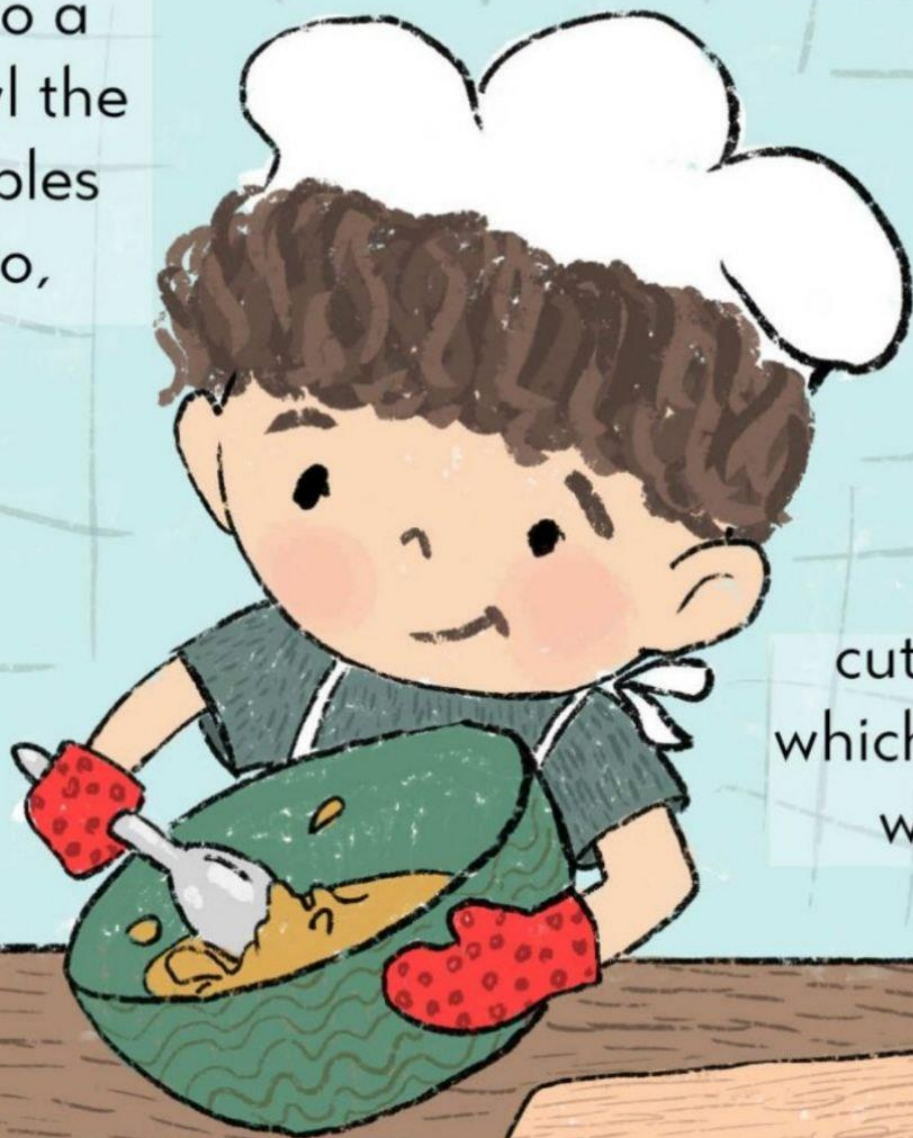
Some are cored, and others diced, and

with delight.

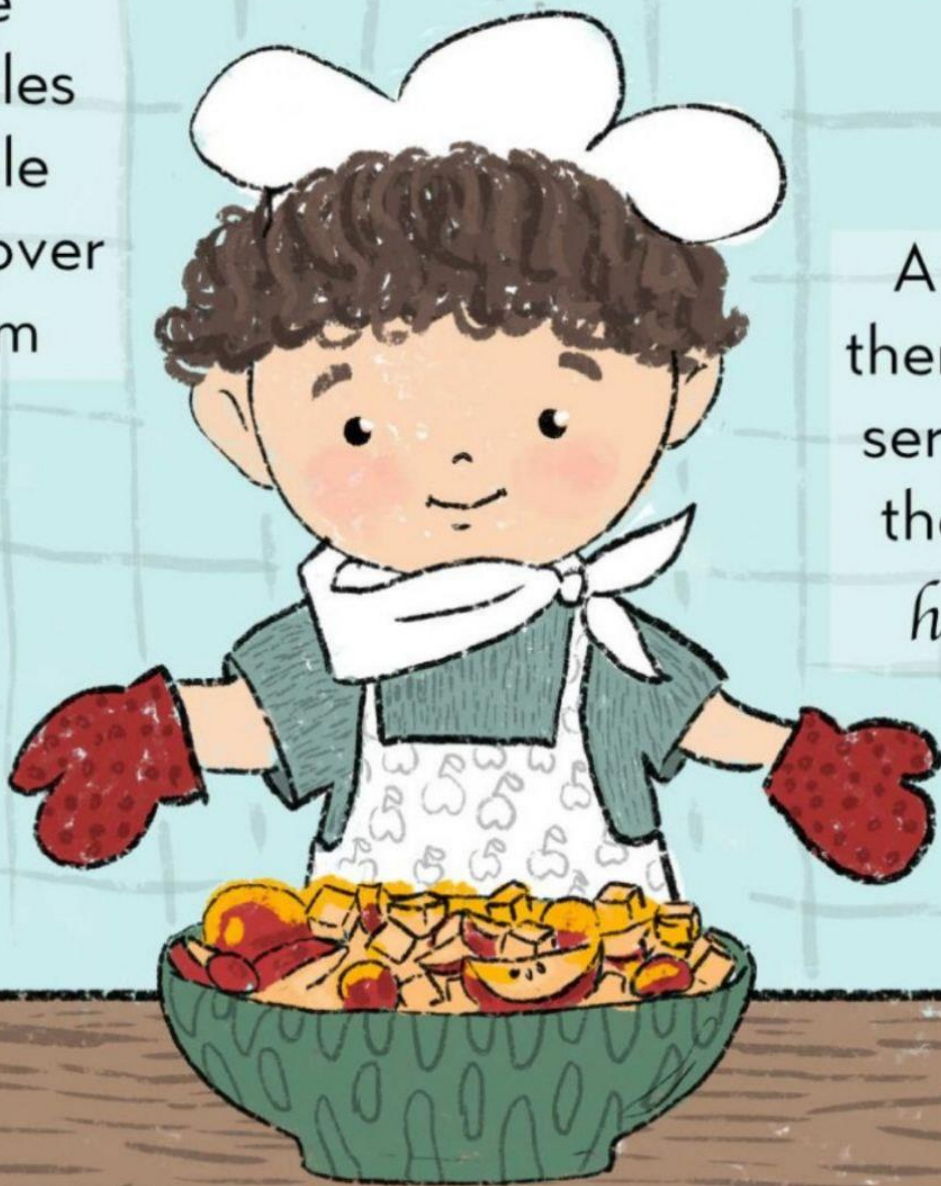
“Just wait till
