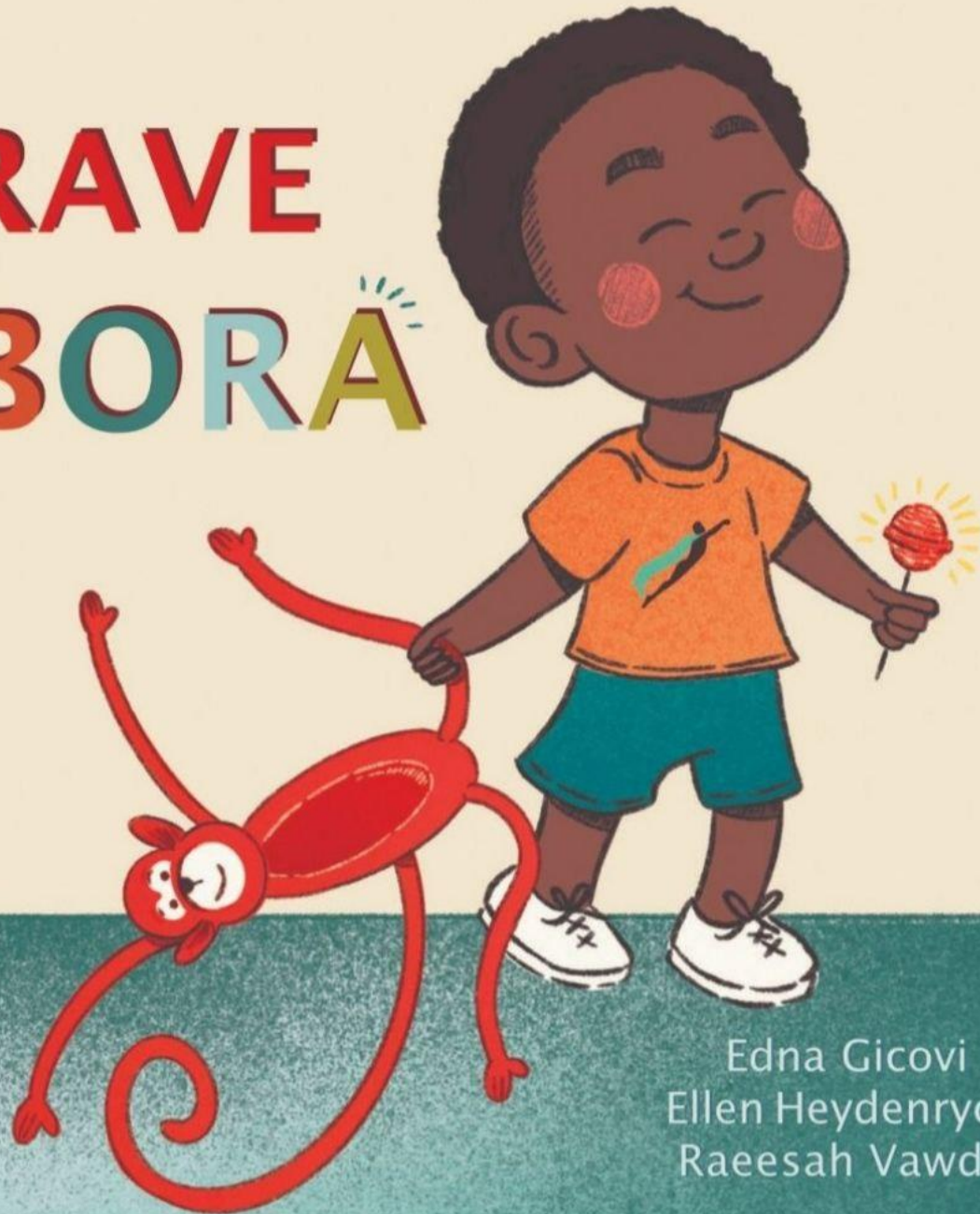


BRAVE BORA

“An injection helps make you healthy. It’s okay to be scared, Bora. Baba will be right here with you. And Jojo too.”

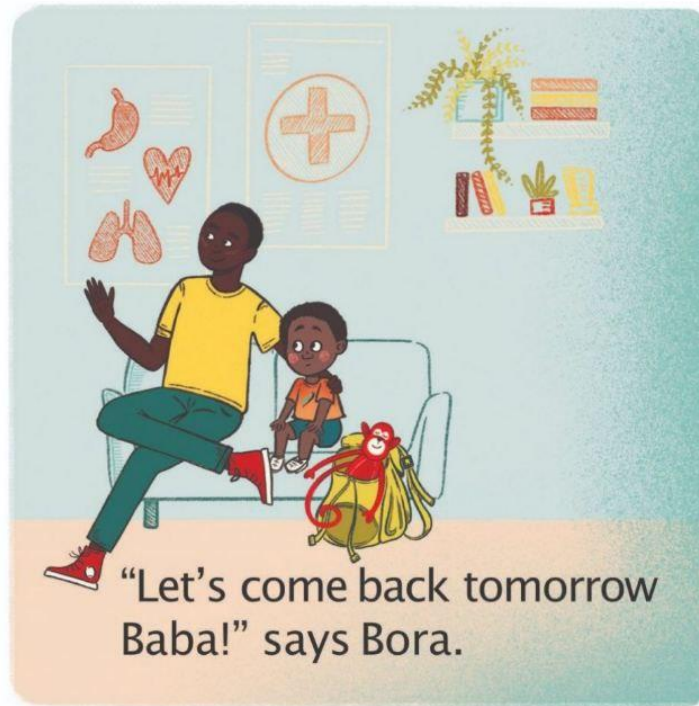




“Bora Baraka!”

“It’s your turn.”



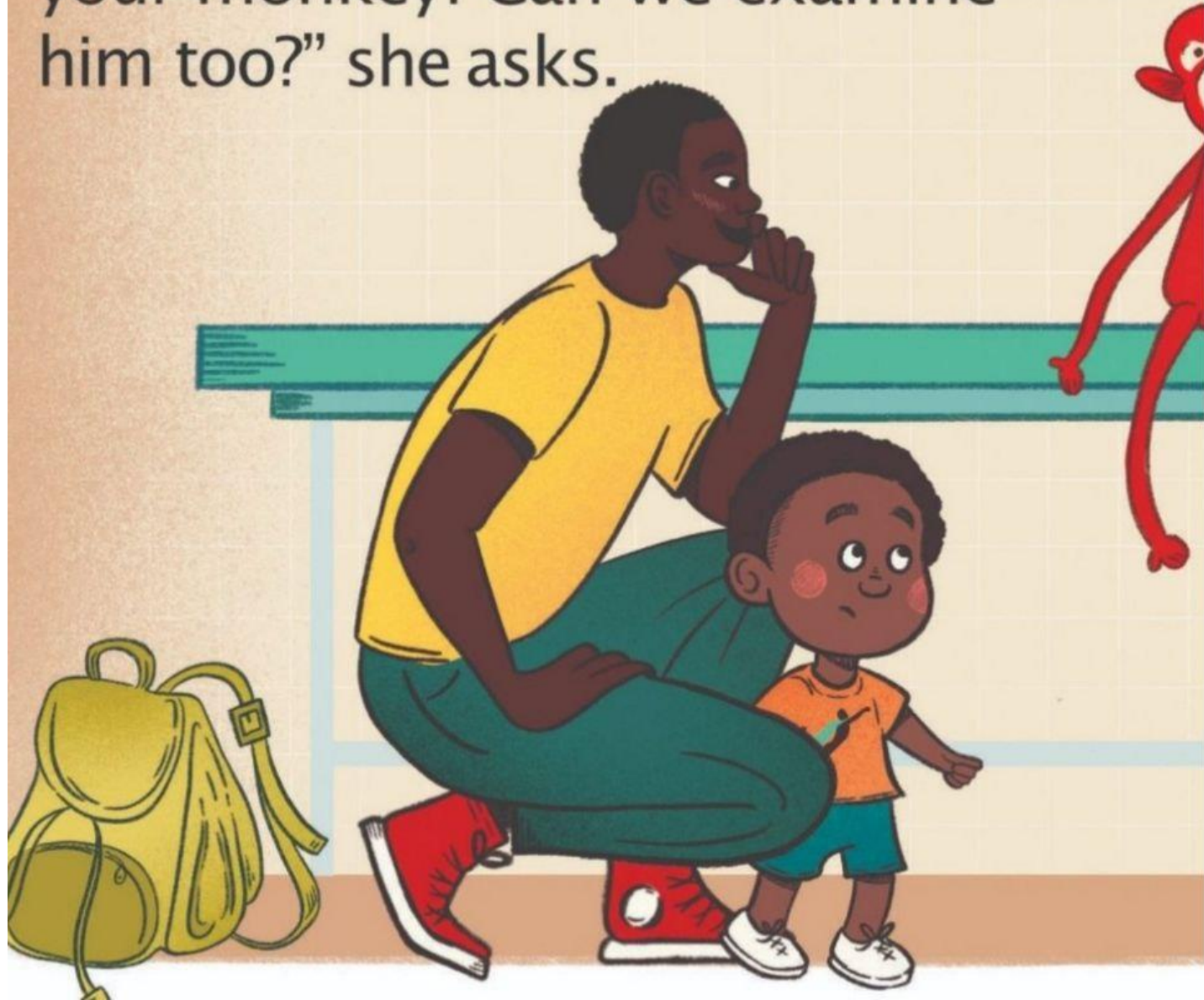
“Let’s come back tomorrow
