green dress.

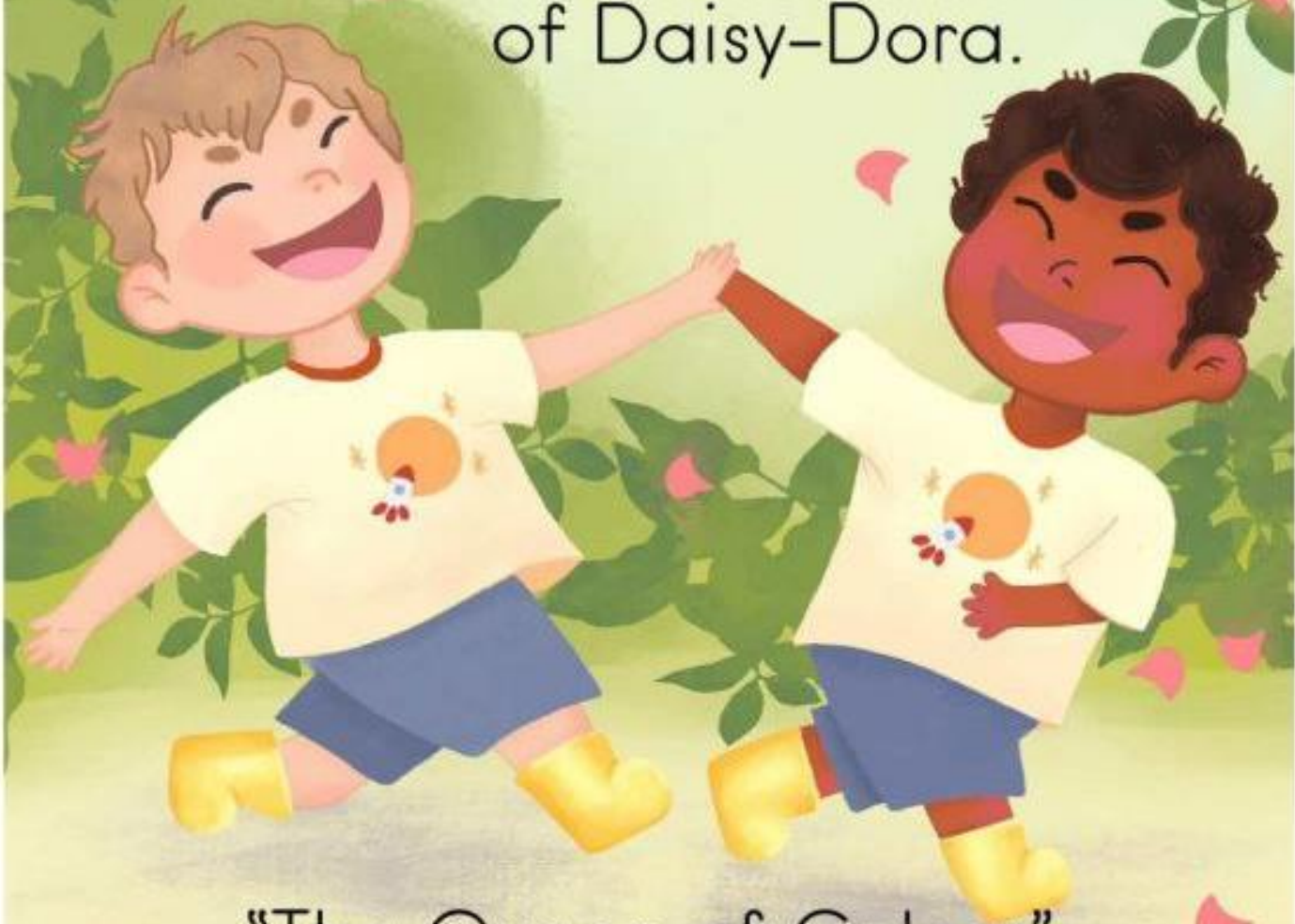


"Like a pea in a pod,"

of Daisy-Dora.



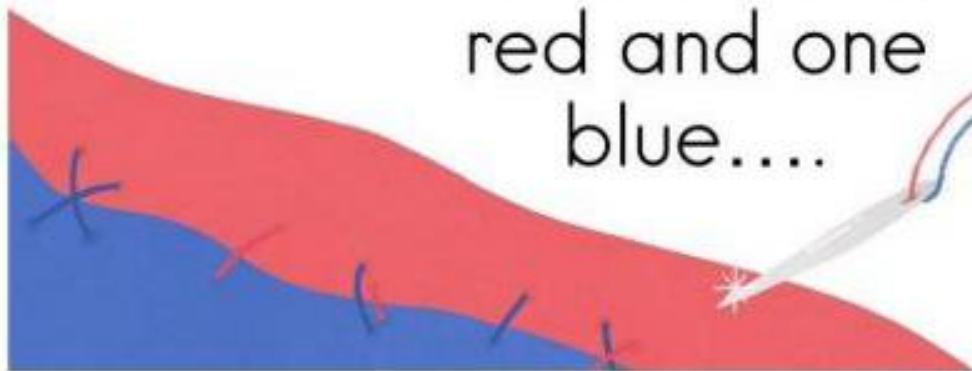
“The Queen of Colour”
they called her...



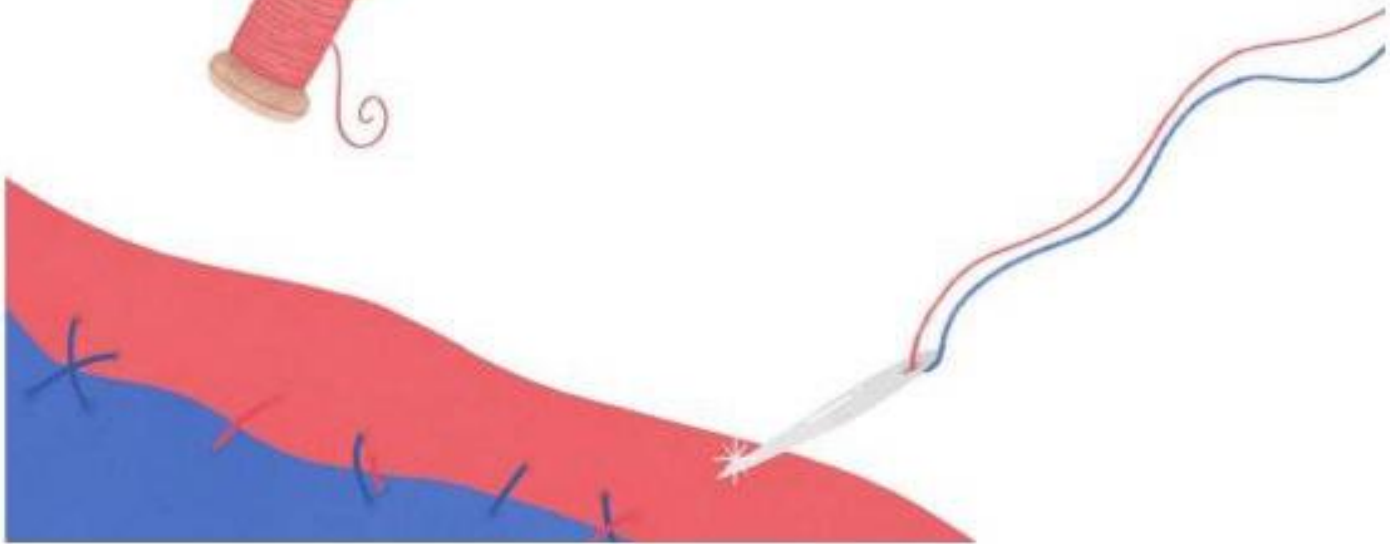
But one day,

middle.





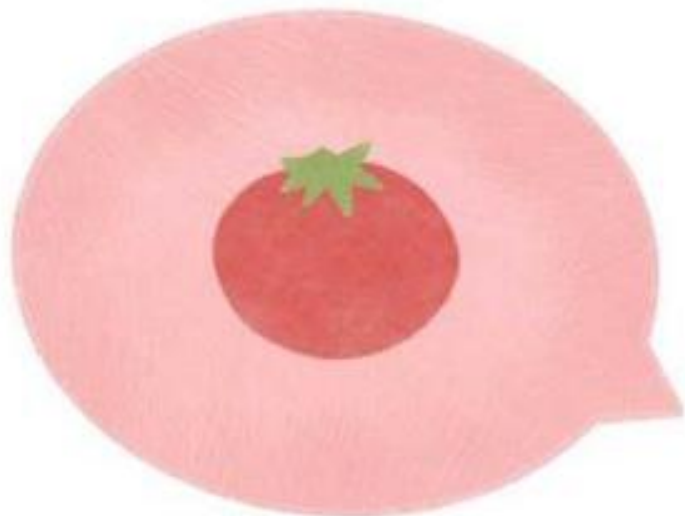
So, now she had a very

One side BLUE.





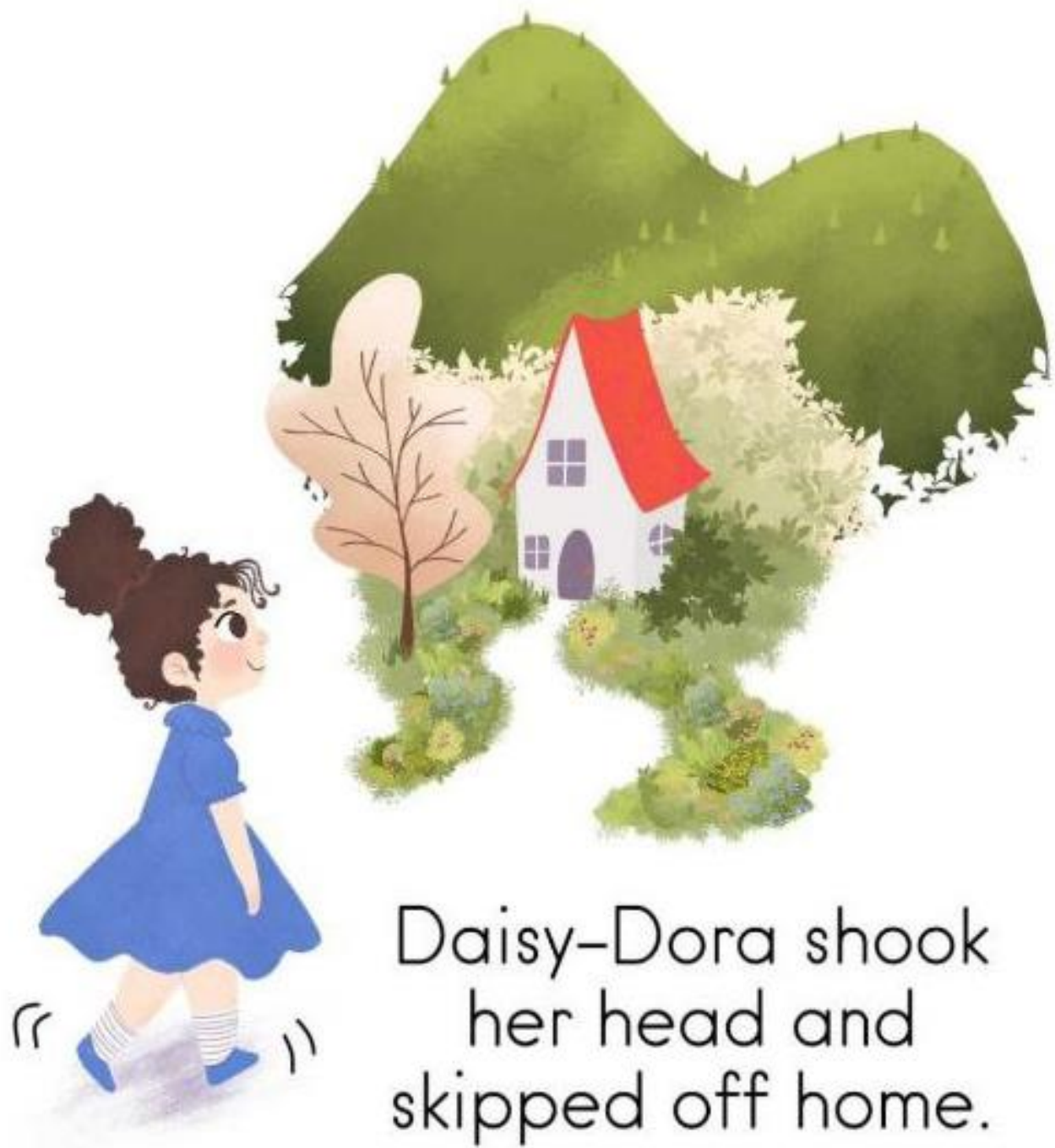
Like she
